TENNIS LESSONS

Birchwood Tennis & Fitness Club offers both members and non-members several **instructional tennis options** that focus on strokes, tactics, and positioning to facilitate improvement for each ability level. Instruction is given and supervised by Birchwood's staff of tennis professionals.

Lessons are offered to juniors and adults through **private sessions, semi-private sessions, and group clinics**. In addition, there are several instructional programs available on a one-time or series basis. The brochure for these programs is posted on our online Junior and Adult Clinics page at www.birchwoodtennis.com and also within the Club's tennis center. Tennis lessons may be arranged through the receptionist within Birchwood's tennis center or by calling the club at 570.586.4030.

Non-members may participate in an unlimited number of tennis lessons and clinics at the specified non-member rates.

JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Through Birchwood Tennis & Fitness Club's **Junior Development Program**, we offer a wide range of group **clinics** and **leagues** throughout the year to develop our younger members' tennis games. Our clinics teach basic tennis skills to beginners and different styles of play and strategy to the more advanced tournament player. Our junior leagues provide up-and-coming players with opportunities to gain match experience and compete against peers in a fun, challenging, and organized way. See our seasonal clinic brochure for session dates and times.

In order to place juniors with others in their age groups and levels, Birchwood categorizes clinic participants into the following groups:

FUTURE STARS (Ages 4-7)

For ages 4-7, players learn fundamental strokes, enjoy games, and have fun! Players use age-appropriate balls and racquets. Graduates of Future Stars move to Champions.

Cost Per Seven-Week Session: \$119 members/\$140 non-members

Cost Per Diem: \$22 members/\$25 non-members

CHAMPIONS (Ages 7-9)

For ages 7-9, including graduates of Future Stars, players practice strokes, receive a more in-depth interpretation of the rules, and enjoy games! Players will use age-appropriate balls and racquets.

Cost Per Seven-Week Session: \$238 members/\$280 non-members

Cost Per Diem: \$40 members/\$45 non-members

TIEBREAKERS (Ages 12 and under)

For ages 12 and under, including graduates of Champions, players piece together the components of strokes, timing, rules, and scoring. Players learn the skills necessary to compete in match play.

Cost Per Seven-Week Session: \$238 members/\$280 non-members

Cost Per Diem: \$40 members/\$45 non-members

DAVIS CUP (Ages 14 and under)

Building on the foundations of Tiebreakers, players refine their strokes with increased emphasis on match play. Students learn more about competitive tennis and tournaments.

HIGH SCHOOL CHALLENGERS (High School Players)

A fun, competitive, and instructional tennis program for high school players. Challengers features drill-based and game-driven instruction that prepares students to match play. Paid per diem.

EXCELLENCE (High School Players)

This program is for advanced high-school players who are preparing for their competitive seasons. Excellence includes a combination of drills, games, and matches. By invitation only. Paid per diem.

BUDDY UP TENNIS, INC. (Adaptive Tennis Program)

“Buddy Up Tennis is a high-energy, adaptive tennis and fitness program for children and young adults with Down syndrome” (www.buddyuptennis.com). We pair experienced volunteer players (Buddies) with our Buddy Up Athletes for an hour-long clinic on Saturday mornings, 10:00 to 11:00 AM. In addition to our junior clinics, Birchwood also offers **junior play days**. Through junior play days, players gain a unique advantage. Juniors who participate in Birchwood’s play days learn competitive skills they cannot learn outside of real match play. They develop on-court responsibility, finesse, and the competitive edge to take them to the next level. Play days provide players the opportunity to take the skills they learn in private lessons & clinics and put them to use in matches against peers. Please inquire about leagues for your skill level.

Further, Birchwood offers year-round **private and semi-private tennis lessons** to both adults and juniors. Lessons are available to those at all levels of play – beginner, intermediate, and advanced.
